Cosplay Rules for Foley Gaming Con

- 1. For safety purposes, all attendees should wear shoes while at the convention. Even if the character goes barefoot, the cosplayer must wear shoes.
- 2. All costumes and outerwear worn by attendees should be appropriate for this family-friendly event. Indecent exposure and nudity will not be tolerated.
- Costumes, props, signs, and outerwear should not contain any language or imagery that
 is profane, offensive, or hateful. Additionally, attire and items cannot endorse any illegal
 or dangerous activities.
- 4. Any and all costume props or weapons are subject to being inspected by security at the door; prop weapons will be specially marked to denote that they have been checked and approved by security. No sharpened weapons/props will be allowed inside the premises, and all real weapons are strictly prohibited.
- Attendees should exercise caution and responsibilities with their costumes and props.
 For instance, inappropriate or reckless behavior using props that may result in yourself or other people being injured is not acceptable.
- 6. If security or con employees deem that a costume or prop violates any of the aforementioned rules or encroaches upon the safety of others, the offending attire/items will not be allowed. This will be decided on a case-by-case basis.
- 7. These rules may be adjusted as needed to ensure the safety of all attendees.
